Brief Day by Day Description

Day 1: Arrival and transfer to Gombe

Arrive at Kigoma Airport. Meet your guide and board a boat to Gombe National Park. The boat ride along Lake Tanganyika takes approximately 1-2 hours and offers scenic views of the lake and surrounding hills. Afternoon Check-in at your Lodge or nearby camp. Lunch the lodge. **Evening** Orientation session with the guide about park rules and chimpanzee tracking. Walk around the lodge familiarize yourself with the surroundings.

Day 2: Chimpanzee and forest walk

Early Morning (6:30 AM), Start chimpanzee tracking in the forest. The guide will lead you through trails to observe chimpanzees in their natural habitat. Learn about their behavior, social structure, and vocalizations. Late Morning (10:30 AM) Return to lodge. Short rest and refreshments. Afternoon Lunch at the lodge. Optional nature walk along forest trails to see birds, monkeys, and unique plants. The guide explains flora and fauna, including medicinal plants used by locals. Evening Dinner at the lodge.

Day 3: Lake Tanganyika and village visit

After breakfast enjoy a boat trip on Lake Tanganyika. Enjoy the stunning views, watch local fishermen at work, and explore the lakeshore. Swimming snorkeling or opportunities (if conditions allow). Afternoon Lunch at the lodge. Visit a nearby local village. Meet locals, learn about daily life, traditional fishing techniques, and local culture. Evening Return to lodge for dinner.

Day 4: Morning Hike and departure

After breakfast, hike to nearby viewpoints or a waterfall if accessible. Spot birds, monkeys, and enjoy the rainforest scenery. Late Morning, Return to lodge for breakfast and packing Checkout and transfer by boat back to Kigoma. Depart via flight.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Climate:

Gombe National Park experiences a warm, tropical climate influenced by its position Lake along Tanganyika. **Temperatures** remain fairly consistent throughout the year, typically warm during the day and cooler in the evenings. The dry season, from June to October, brings sunny skies and excellent trekking conditions with minimal rainfall. The rainy season, from November to May, is marked by heavier showers and lush areen vegetation, creating vibrant forest scenery but sometimes making trails slippery. Overall, Gombe's climate is mild and welcoming, offering rewarding wildlife experiences in every season.

Clothing and Footwear:

- Lightweight cotton, long sleeves for sun protection
- Warm layers for cold nights
- Waterproof jacket and raincoat
- Hiking boots for trekking
- Shoes for wearing in the bush

- Sunglasses, sunscreen
- Binoculars

Visas and Permits:

European travellers (including Dutch, Belgian, German, and most EU citizens) require a visa to enter Tanzania/Zanzibar.

You can obtain a Tourist Visa on arrival at the airport or port of entry, or apply online before travel via the official eVisa website:

The tourist visa costs USD 50 per person and is valid for up to 90 days for single entry. (Please bring cash for this)

Multiple-entry visas and business visas are also available if needed.

Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your entry date and have at least one blank page.

Tip: It's often quicker to apply online in advance, as airport queues for visa on arrival can sometimes be long

Vaccinations & Health Advice: Vaccination requirements & other health advice can change, so please check with a specialized travel clinic for upto-date information before you depart.

Entry requirement

A certificate of yellow fever vaccination is required for travellers aged ≥ 1 year only if arriving from a country with risk of yellow fever transmission.

If coming directly from a "nonyellow-fever risk" country, yellow fever vaccine may not be required.

Recommended vaccinations Yellow fever: Generally not required for travellers arriving directly to Tanzania from lowrisk countries. However, if your group is coming from, or transiting through, a country with a yellow fever risk, the certificate is required.

Local costs: 4 Breakfasts, 4 lunches and 4 dinner are included.

Approximate costs are for guidance only and may vary widely according to location and type of establishment.

Tipping and Gratuities:

For better or worse, tipping is an accepted part of everyday life, and - although it is always at your discretion - you will be expected to tip to reward service. Your tour guide will give you an indication of when and how much is appropriate. This can vary widely, the following is suggested Hotel Staff :USD 2.00 per person per day Waiters: 10% of bill equivalent Safari Guide: USD 15.00 per

person per day

Seasonal changes: Although all rooms/chalets in malaria areas that we use are protected with mosquito netting; there will be insects and mosquitoes about. The camps, lodges and resorts are essentially fresco" so you should be prepared with insect repellent appropriate sleeved/legged clothing. Insects are attracted to light at especially night and are prevalent during the rainy season. Switching the lights off and placing a hurricane lamp a distance from you will remove the problem.

The evenings and mornings will be chilly from about June to

August: so, it is advisable to take a light sweater or fleece

Currency: Official currency is Tanzanian Shilling (ZS) Other currencies commonly accepted

US Dollars are widely accepted, especially in:

Hotels, resorts, and tourist restaurants

However, smaller local shops,

markets, and taxis usually prefer Tanzanian shillings. Important to note Newer US Dollar notes only: Many places do not accept notes printed before 2009, and they prefer clean, undamaged \$50 or \$100 bills for the best

Change is often given in shillings, even if you pay in USD.

exchange rate.

Euros and GBP can be exchanged, but are not commonly used directly for payment.

ATMs are available in Stone Town and major resorts; they dispense Tanzanian shillings.

NB: Pre-2009-dollar bills are not accepted in most African countries




